#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOWNLOADING IMAGES AND VIDEO

- Downloading full resolution images
  - Click on the item you want to download from the Web page
  - A window will pop up that displays the jpeg. Click on the Description tab
  - Scroll to the bottom of the page to the Full Resolution field
  - Right-click on the hyperlink in the Full Resolution field (the file will end with .tif)
  - Choose "Save Target As..." and save the image file to your computer's hard drive
  
- Downloading JPEGs
  - Click on the item you want to download from the Web page
  - A window will pop up that displays the JPEG
  - Right-click on the JPEG and Choose "Save Picture As". Save the image file to your computer's hard drive
  
- Downloading video
  - Click on the item you want to download from the Web page
  - A window will pop up that displays a still image. Click on the Description tab
  - Scroll to the Play Video field
  - Right-click on the hyperlink that says Download
  - Choose "Save Target As..." and save the video file to your computer's hard drive
