

### Computer Printing

Laser printing is available from public computers in the library. Printers are located near the Public Services desk on the main level. All printing is fee-based. Payment can be cash, UCard, or credit card. All printing goes through a print queue. Inform library staff of the computer's name-number to collect and pay for print jobs, as well as to cancel print jobs. Color printing is also available.

### Reference Services

Although most Reference services, such as consultation and instruction are provided for **free**, Reference staff can perform mediated online database searches. Search fees are based on time or vendor charges (usually cost plus 50%.) Monthly current awareness searches can be arranged, but most databases provide current awareness services for free. Ask us!
