2. Treasurer's Update:

 - b. The budget is now in excess of \$6,000
3. Review of UHSLC Goals and Objectives
 - a. UHSLC Digitization project: to collect and digitize UHSLC materials, give them some historical context, and make the collection available on the Web.
 - i. Wayne Peay, the Director of the Eccles Health Sciences Library at the University of Utah has stated that he is committed to providing resources and personnel for the development of the project
 - ii. A UHSLC collection has been created in CONTENTdm
 - iii. A group of implementers have been assigned specific tasks: Linda Von Wagner will be asked to oversee metadata development, Valeri Craigle, and Liz Workman will design a website and UHSLC logo, the rest of the group will provide feedback and expertise when needed.
 - b. Reference Continuity Service
 - i. The project has received variable feedback. Will discuss at a future date.
 - c. Serhold Compliance and Training
 - i. Our goal is to have 100% compliance
 - ii. Laura Jones (laura@lib.med.utah.edu) and John Bramble (jbramble@lib.med.utah.edu) are available to provide assistance. Laura can assist with cataloging and John can provide training
 - d. Professional Development
 - i. Poster for MCMLA: The abstract deadline has been extended. This year that plan is to focus on the UHSLC Digitization Project
 - ii. Career fair campaign for health sciences librarians
