



What are QR Codes?



A **QR Code** is a 2D code that enables those with the appropriate reader (for example, a **QR Code** mobile device application) to "scan" the code in order to view further information. **QR Codes** can contain links to websites (which is mainly how the Eccles Library uses them), text, or other data. In addition to around the library, you may have noticed them in magazines, billboards, newspapers, and even on price tags at stores. If not, look for them. **QR Codes** can be very useful in finding more information about a variety of things.
