Introduction

This breakout session is intended for course, clerkship, or residency directors who are interested in integrating CAI in their curriculum. Based on their experience integrating CLIPP (Computer-assisted Learning In Pediatrics Project), the session presenters will briefly introduce the successes and challenges to CAI integration. The multi-institutional use of this CAI program offers valuable insights previously unavailable.

Abstract

Although many CAI programs have been developed, less attention has been paid to getting these programs used by learners. The session presenters will focus the group discussion on an approach to CAI use that emphasizes making the program an integral component of the overall learning experience, while also assessing needs of the learner and educator.
