PARK CITY TRANSIT:

Welcome to the Park City/Summit County FREE bus system. From 7:30 a.m. until 10:30 p.m. daily, our buses will take you just about anywhere you want to go. Buses serve Park City's Historic District, lodging, shopping and dining areas within Park City and Kimball Junction, three world-class ski areas and residential neighborhoods. We encourage you to save time, energy and money by riding the bus!

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE:

- Locate your trip destination on the map. (There is one map for destinations within Park City and another for bus routes that continue to destinations in Summit County.)
- Locate your trip origin. (Not every destination and location can be listed in this guide but you should be able to locate one nearby.)
- Routes serving selected destinations are indicated by color in this guide.
- Identify the nearest route(s) serving your trip. If not a single route, major transfer points are Park City Mountain Resort and Old Town Transit Center.
- Service frequencies are indicated on the maps. Scheduled departure times for each route are posted at bus stops and inside the Old Town Transit Center.

BUS STOPS:

For passenger safety, drivers are instructed to only pick-up and drop-off passengers at bus stops. Bus stops are easy to find. Just look for the blue signs with white lettering. Routes serving the stop and departure times will also be posted at each stop. The location of all bus stops and transfer points are indicated on the route maps. Please plan to arrive at the bus stop a few minutes before

the scheduled departure time. As the bus approaches, please check the bus destination sign to ensure you are boarding the correct bus.

WHILE ON THE BUS:

Welcome aboard. Traffic and parking around town can be challenging, so please ride the bus and relax. Our drivers can also be a good source of information while you are visiting so please feel free to ask questions. If all seats are full please move away from the doors to allow others to board. Seats near the front of the bus should be offered to the elderly and riders with disabilities. For the safety and comfort of all passengers, please refrain from playing radios, cassettes or CD's without earphones

while on the bus. Smoking, eating, drinking, and animals (except service animals) are not allowed.

MAIN STREET TROLLEY SERVICE:

The Trolley operates along Main Street daily from 10:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. It will stop just about anywhere along Main Street. Stand at any of the Trolley stop signs or just give a wave to the driver indicating you would like to ride. The Trolley also serves as a link between Main Street and the Old Town Transit Center where connections can be made to all other routes in the system.



DIAL-A-RIDE:

Service is available to the Park City Ice Arena and Sports Complex and the National Ability Center. For more information please call 435-640-7819 between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.. Dial-A-Ride guides are available on all Park City Transit buses.

LOST AND FOUND:

Before leaving the bus, always check for personal items. If you do forget something, please leave a message at 435-615-5350.

PARK CITY MOBILITY:

All Park City/Summit County transit buses are ADA accessible and drivers are trained to assist those with disabilities. Door-to-door Paratransit service is also provided for passengers that are unable to use the fixed route service. SAFE HAVEN PROGRAM:

If you feel that you are in imminent danger, just board a Park City Transit bus. Drivers are in direct contact with the police department.
